Procedural Changes – Beginning Fall 2012, Illinois will unveil Illinois Transportation Automated Permit System (ITAP). ITAP will be rolled out in two phases:

Phase I – Fall of 2012. ITAP will automatically process and issue successful applications for ALL Routine Permits and a limited number of Superload Permits. Specifically, it will auto issue those superload permits with dimensions up to 16’ wide, 17’ high with no more than maximum Routine weight. For example, a superload application for 15’ 8” wide, 16’ 8” high, 6 axle tractor semi-trailer combination weighing 120,000 lbs gross will generally be automatically issued as soon as you submit your application. In addition, it will automatically process and issue ALL Limited Continuous Operation permits (LCO’s) including both Quarterly and Annual LCO’s.

Phase II – Fall of 2013. All permits, both routine and superload up to 16’ wide and 17’ high will be automatically issued.
